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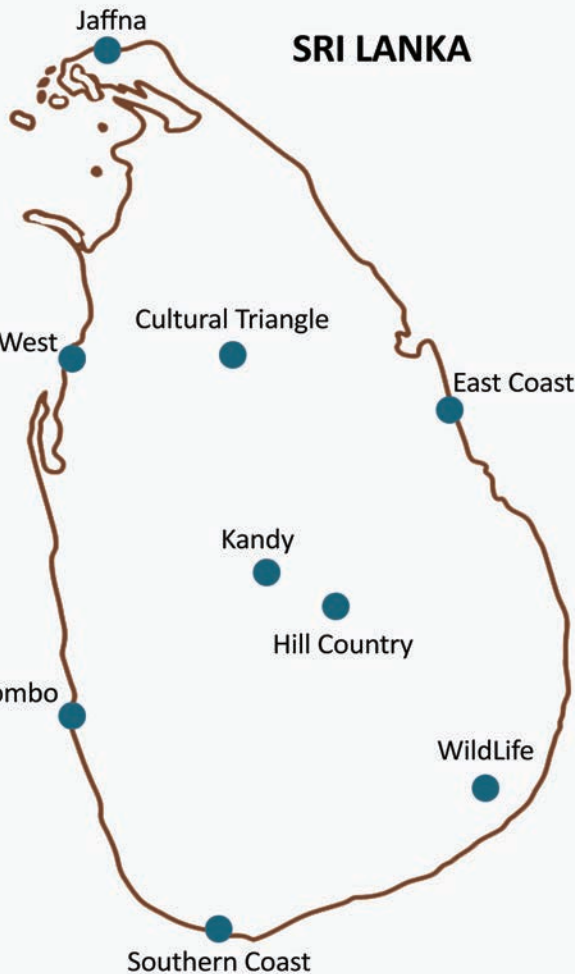

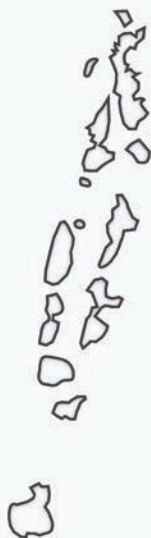

Ruins of the ancient times which speaks out loud the glorious history of our nation, A rock fortress built by King Kasshyapa also known as the lion's rock, man-built Stupa paying homage to relics considered sacred to many Buddhists, all lie within this triangle to quench the thirst of all cultural enthusiasts
